

## SECTION OF THE WORKS: ENYONELA'S PUMPKIN MUFFINS

- Note the use of puree instead of the canned variety here. I think it's expected now you bake. Enjoy! And if you have any questions:
1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees F.
  2. Grease a standard 12-cup muffin pan.
  3. In a small bowl, mix together flour, spices, baking powder and sea salt. Set aside.
  4. In a large bowl, whisk together pumpkin puree and melted butter until smooth.
  5. Add brown sugar and granulated sugar and whisk until combined and there are no lumps.
  6. Add eggs and vanilla and stir combine.
  7. Add dry ingredients and stir batter is smooth.
  8. Pour 1/2 cup of the mixture into each well of the muffin pan. Smooth out the top.
  9. Bake in preheated oven for 20 minutes, or until the tops are a cake tested inserted into the top comes out clean with few crumbs.
  10. Let pumpkin muffins cool a minute, then remove from the pan and transfer back to cool completely.
